

Illinois Whitetail and Waterfowl Rules and Regulations 2021

General Rules:

- All Illinois State and Federal hunting laws are to be abided. It is the responsibility of the client to read the Illinois DNR game laws.
- No consumption of alcohol or other mood-altering substances prior to hunting.
- The Hunter log book must be completely filled out prior to hunting.
- NO LOADED FIREARMS ARE ALLOWED IN HOUSES AT ANYTIME.
- All weapons are to be cased and/or locked per the Illinois state law.
- NO confrontation with Farmers, landowners, neighbors and fellow hunter in camp.
- NO smoking in house.
- NO smoking on stand or in blinds.
- Hunter must go straight to and from parking and / or drop off.
- Do not wonder around the woods and fields to scout.
- Unless you see animal fall, do not track the animal. Wait for Outfitter to track the animal.
- Fall restraint must be worn at all times on stand.
- Inform outfitter of damaged or unsafe stands / blind.

Harvest Rules:

- 140" minimum gross score.
- Fine for deer that fall under the 140" score is \$75.00 per inch under 140.
- Fines are doubled on the last day of hunt.
- Drawing of blood results in cease of the hunt until final determination by Outfitter.
- Mature buck scoring less than 140" may be taken upon approval or direction from the outfitter.
